

DIPLOMA IN MEDICAL ASSISTING WITH PHLEBOTOMY TECHNICIAN

Program Description

The "Medical Assistant with Phlebotomy Program" trains students to assist healthcare professionals by performing fundamental clinical and administrative tasks in hospitals, clinics, and medical centers. They are the members of a medical team that includes registered nurses and physicians.

The Medical Assisting With Phlebotomy Technician diploma program curriculum includes medical terminology, anatomy and physiology, pharmacology, microbiology, and immunology fundamental concepts. Law and ethics, as well as effective communication skills, are taught to students. Students are taught the fundamentals of medical equipment and devices, patient care management and medical records, insurance, patient preparation, and basic laboratory procedures are also covered in this complete course.

During the duration of 10 months, students are also educated and trained in the field of phlebotomy, where they can also avail clinical externships, which are necessary for certification. Students who successfully complete diploma in Medical Assisting with Phlebotomy Technician will be awarded a Certificate of Completion from our State-approved College. Students can also take the National Certification Exams to become a Certified Medical Assistant and Phlebotomy Technician.
